2019-2020

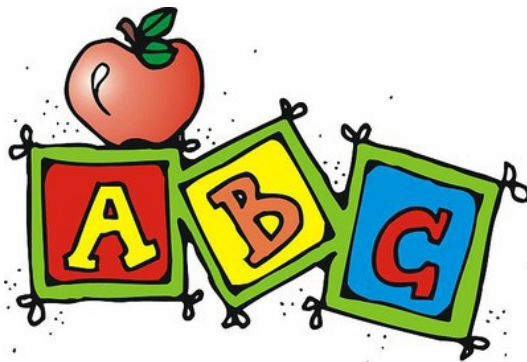
Each Kindergarten student, please bring:

- One backpack (large enough to hold: a 3-ringed binder, a lunch box, a coat and larger art projects. Labeled with name.)
- 1 box of colored markers (8-10 set, washable, wide-tip. Crayola preferred)
- 2 erasers (Ping Pearl or similar)
- 24 glue sticks - Elmer's preferred
- 2 or more small tip dry erase marker, Black (Expo brand only)
- 1 pair of small scissors (Fiskar brand preferred)
- 3 boxes - 24 count crayons (Crayola preferred)
- 24 pencils (Ticonderoga preferred)
- 1 set of watercolor paints (small set of Crayola or Prang brands)

Boys, please bring: 1 box of gallon or sandwich sized Ziplock bags

Girls, please bring: 1 box of tissues

Optional item: 1 container of Baby wipes

The following supplies will be collected:

24 sharpened #2 pencils (Ticonderoga are preferred because they last longer and sharpen well)

15 glue sticks

1 package baby wipes

Girls-1 box Ziploc gallon bags

Boys-1 box Kleenex tissue



Please label the following supplies with your child's name:

1 backpack

1 box of markers

2 watercolor paints (we run out of colors mid-year, so 2 are necessary. Crayola works best.)

1 one inch white 3 ring **view** binder (heavy duty quality)

2 boxes of 24 count Crayola crayons

1 pair of scissors (Fiskars work well)





Please mark items with your child's name.

- *Coloring Supplies: 1 pkg color pencils, 1 box crayons, (24 ct. or more) 1 box Crayola markers**
- *1 watercolor paint set (Prang is best pigment quality)**
- *1 plastic shoe storage box to store supplies (no larger than 13 5/8L x 8 1/4W)**
- 1/2 inch white binder with a clear front cover pocket**
(If a 1/2 inch binder is difficult to find then a 1 inch binder will be ok)
- *1 pencil pouch with clear front for binder (so notes are easy to see)**
- *3 Composition Books (wide ruled)**
- *1 pr. Scissors (Fiskers work well)**

The remaining items will be shared communally, so please do not label with child's name:

- *10 glue sticks (solid kind, not liquid)**
- *24 or more #2 pencils (Ticonderoga If possible, sharpen please)**
- *2 erasers (large pink)**
- *4 blue, black, or green ONLY Expo markers**
- *Pkg of post its**
- *Ziplock bags (quart and gallon sized)**
- *Box of tissues**
- *1 package of baby wipes**
- *1 box of a nonperishable food item (crackers, cereal bars, fruit snacks, etc.) to be used when a student forgets their snack. (Please no candy)**

Mount Erie Third Grade Supply List 2019-2020

Your child will need the following school supplies:

Label the following items with your child's name:

- 1 backpack
- 1 pair scissors (Fiskars or equivalent)
- 1 pkg. of 24 colored pencils
- 2 quality handheld pencil sharpeners w/shavings holders
- 1 watercolor paint set (Prang or equivalent)
- 4 wide-ruled composition books (no spiral notebooks)
- Boyes: 1 clear plastic shoebox-size storage box with lid. These must fit in a 7" tall x 8.5" wide cubby.
- Hofheimer and Olsen: 1 pencil box. No larger than standard 8.5 x 6 inch size to fit in desk.

Leave the following items **unlabeled**:

- 24 #2 pencils (sharpened, if possible)
- 2 large pink erasers
- 4 glue sticks
- 1 package of baby wipes (56 count)
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 box of gallon-size Ziploc bags- last name A-M
- 1 container of hand sanitizer (12 oz.) - last name N-Z

Supplies that will go into general class reserves:

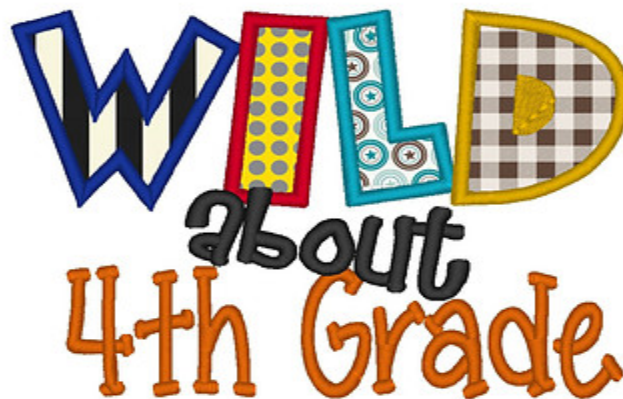
4 dozen **Ticonderoga** #2 pencils (sharpened if possible)
